### PROJECT ACCESSION AGREEMENT "CL SUMMER SCHOOL AND &UM TRAINING COURSES FOR EU&UA PARTICIPANTS"

#### §1

This agreement is a form of contract between:

#### §2

- I. The primary objective of participation in the project is to acquire theoretical and practical skills in the analysis, evaluation and application of currently existing urban logistics practices and tools to enable effective decision-making to improve urban logistics using intelligent technologies.
- II. The Project Participant is required to act in accordance with the requirements specified in the Rules and Regulations of the Summer School, which constitute an annex to this agreement.
- III. The Participant acknowledges that in case of resignation from the Project before its completion, or in case of removal from the list of the Project's Participants for reasons attributable to the Participant, he/she may be obliged to reimburse costs related to his/her education in an amount not higher than the amount budgeted for in the Project's budget.
- IV. The Participant declares that he/she has become acquainted with the Rules and Regulations of Participation in the Project and, being aware of the legal liability for making false statements, undertakes to abide by the terms and conditions.

- V. The contract has been drawn up in two identical copies: one for the Participant and one for the Poznan School of Logistics.

#### DATA PRIVACY NOTICE

In accordance with Articles 13(1) and (2) and Article 14(1) and (2) of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data and repealing Directive 95/46/EC [RODO], I inform you that:

- III. Your personal data will be processed for the purposes of the Summer School.
- IV. The processing of personal data for purposes and to the extent beyond the personal data necessary for the purposes arising from the educational process of the Summer School requires your consent.
- V. The provision of personal data is voluntary, but necessary for the implementation of the educational process within the framework of the Summer School. If you do not provide your data, it will not be possible to fulfil the above-mentioned purpose.
- VI. The recipients of your data are authorised employees of Poznan School of Logistics, the EIT, entities and individuals providing insurance services to the Administrator, legal services and other entities to whom the Administrator has entrusted personal data. The recipients of your data are also institutions and entities legally authorised to receive your data on the basis of relevant legislation.
- VII. Your personal data will not be transferred to third countries or international organisations within the scope of the GDPR.
- VIII. You have the right to:
  - a. access to your personal data (pursuant to Article 15 of the GDPR);
  - b. rectification of your personal data (pursuant to Article 16 of the GDPR);
  - c. deletion of your personal data (pursuant to Article 17 of the GDPR);

- d. request the Controller to restrict the processing of personal data, subject to the cases referred to in Article 18(2) GDPR; the right to restrict processing shall not apply in relation to storage in order to ensure the exercise of legal remedies or to protect the rights of another natural or legal person, or for compelling reasons of public interest of the European Union or of a Member State;
  - e. file a complaint with the President of the Data Protection Authority if you consider that the processing of your personal data violates the provisions of the GDPR.
- IX.
