Some changes in the process for ELA Certification

- First of all we have a new President as you might have heard, his name is Markus Mau. From the ELA Board Xavier Rius from Spain is taking the lead on ELA Certification. Last month a first meeting took place to see where we are at the moment and to discuss the road to go.
- As ECBL the European Certification Board for Logistics no longer exists the ELA Board decided to name the activities 'ELA Certification'.
- To be more sustainable and agile the ELA Board decided that from now on we will produce the certificates in a digital format to send them via email to the organisations. This way we avoid delays but also potential damages and or lost in the mail. The institute can print out these certificates on 160 gram paper (manageable by any printer) or have it printed via a service.
- All candidate certificates will have an expiring date.
- Accreditation of bachelor programs will only be on level 4. The reasoning is that bachelors hardly ever will start in a middle management position. Master programs will be accredited on level 6.
- As a reminder, order for less than 5 certificates will have an extra charge for administration on the invoice.
